|  <p>Reading</p> | <p>Please read with your child at least x3 per week and record a comment in your child's Reading Record.</p> <p>Please hand in the Reading Record on a Friday, which will be signed by us and we will return the Reading Record to you on the following Monday. You will still have a reading book to read over the weekend. We will change the children's reading books on a Thursday and Monday.</p> |
|  <p>Spellings</p> | <p>Spelling Rule: The /ck/ sound. This sound is usually spelt as 'ck' and comes straight after a single vowel letter in short words.</p> <p>back neck click suck block black deck tick truck clock</p> <p>We are all giving our spellings a really good go and we are super proud of you. We will have a little spelling test on a Wednesday.</p> |
|  <p>Maths</p> | <p>Can you count out sets of objects and write number labels for them? For example, you could count out all your dolls and make number labels, pieces of Lego, books, teddies, 13, 23, etc. Have you written your numbers correctly and round the right way? (Parents - please note it is still very common for year 1s to reverse their numbers at this time of the year!) E.g. back to front 2s, 5s 3s etc. Please just gently point this out and remind them how to write the numbers correctly.</p> |
|  <p>Design Technology</p> | <p>We have noticed that some children have difficulty holding a pair of scissors correctly and cutting. Please could you help your child with their cutting skills? We have included some shapes for them to cut out. If you require a paper print out please ask.</p> |
