 <p><b>Reading</b></p>	<p>Please read with your child at least x3 per week and record a comment in your child's Reading Record.</p> <p>Please <b>hand in</b> the <b>Reading Record</b> on a <b>Friday</b>, which will be signed by us and we will return the <b>Reading Record</b> to you on the following Monday. You will still have a reading book to read over the weekend. We will change the children's reading books on a Thursday and Monday.</p>
 <p><b>Spellings</b></p>	<p><b>Spelling Rule:</b> Adding s and es to words (plurals). If the ending sounds like /s/ or /z/, it is spelled as -s. If it forms an extra syllable, then it is spelled as -es.</p> <p>flowers boxes lunches apples beaches trees dishes dogs peaches clouds</p> <p>We are all giving our spellings a really good go and we are super proud of you. We will have a little spelling test on a <b>Wednesday</b>.</p>
 <p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>Try and log on to Numbots and earn lots of coins.</p> <p>We have been learning how to subtract in maths.
