<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> 	<p>Please read with your child at least x3 per week and record a comment in your child's Reading Record.</p> <p>Please hand in the Reading Record on a Friday, which will be signed by us and we will return the Reading Record to you on the following Monday. You will still have a reading book to read over the weekend.</p> <p>We will change the children's reading books on a Thursday and Monday.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Spellings</p> 	<p>Spelling Rule: Words ending '-tch'. The /ch/ sound is usually spelt as 'tch' when it comes after a single vowel letter.</p> <p>catch kitchen hutch ditch match fetch notch witch stretch watch</p> <p>We will have a little spelling test on a Wednesday.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> 	<p>Next week we shall be focusing on our number bonds (two numbers that go together) to make 10. Children need to be able to recall these rapidly and know the facts by heart. E.g. $3+7=10$, $7+3=10$.</p> <p>If you have a computer please explore the Hit the Button game to help you learn your facts speedily.</p> <p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</p> <p>If you don't have a computer, can you practise by counting out objects practically? E.g 7 Lego pieces + 3 Lego pieces =10.</p>
