Dear Parents,

It was great to see some more of our Foundation, Y1 and Y6 children who joined us on Monday. If your child is returning to school next week, please remember to send in any medication that they might need. Many children took this home with them when school closed in March and it is important that this is returned. Please also remember that if you require a school lunch for your child, these will need to be booked online the Tuesday before your child returns to school. Chartwells are converting these to a packed lunch for the time being.

As mentioned last week, the government announced that schools could consider bringing more children back if they had capacity. Having considered a variety of scenarios, we have come to the conclusion that there is no additional space available within our school, nor available staff to teach and supervise additional classes of children. However, depending on whether or not current children are utilising their place at school, we may be able to offer some targeted support for a very small number of identified children. Parents of these children will be contacted if a space becomes available. We are very sorry but we no longer have any spaces for critical worker children – we have reached capacity.

Thank you to all our parents for adhering to social distancing when you come on site and following the one-way system. It is important that this continues for the remainder of the year.
