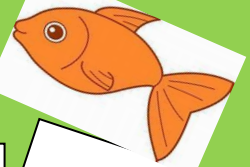

In Science, we will be learning to;

- Identify and name a variety of common animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describe and compare the structure of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets.)

English

The children will learn how to write recounts of events, using the past tense. We will also write some fantastic poems and stories based on texts with predictable and patterned language.

The Victorians

In History, we will learn about The Victorians. We will look at the similarities and differences between school life in the past and school life today. We will also be learning about other aspects of Victorian times, including home life. We will dress as Victorians and visit Holdenbury House on 10th Dec.

Maths Learning:

For our Maths learning, we will be solving problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and writing number sentences using mathematical signs. Near the end of the half term, we will explore Geometry, identifying and categorising 2D and 3D shapes by their properties.

Developing our understanding of 2D and 3D in terms of artwork - paintings/sculpture.

Investigating a range of different materials and experimenting with how they can be connected together to form simple structures.
