English

Our class text this term will be @Journey to Jo'burg by Beverley Naidoo. We will study this novel in our reading lessons. We will also use this text to inspire our writing.

In Maths, the children be learning about fractions: how to add, subtract and convert them into equivalent fractions. The children will also revise their knowledge of perimeter and area.

In History, our topic is 'Zulu Kingdom'. The children will be learning about the Zulu Nation, colonisation and to making links between British and Zulu history. The children will learn about how we understand the past through sources, artefacts and propaganda.

In science, our topic this term is all about Space! This engaging topic focuses on the planets in our solar system - the differences and their similarities. In addition, the children learn about how the earth, sun and moon interact with each other.
