During STEM lessons, the children will have the opportunity to design, build and erupt their own volcanoes.

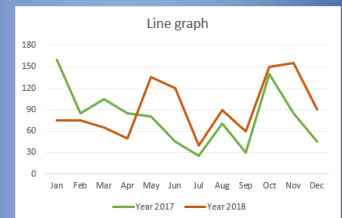
In Geography, the children will be learning about how natural disasters occur.

In Science, the children will be focusing on electricity. We will look at the different symbols and draw circuits.

To finish the topic, the children will make their own circuits to investigate the brightness of a bulb, and how the position of switches affect it.
